The concept of social agriculture was brought to the province thanks to the activities of the cooperative, which helped to mainstream this social practice.

After that, the cooperative became active in the working group of provincial law on social agriculture for the implementation of a national law regarding the topic (approved in 2015). An improvement in the working conditions of the providers of childcare services was also achieved.



This project gives women from rural areas the opportunity to become part of their team.


Any woman can apply for training to become a childminder and later work for this social cooperative.



Social farming allows the people to connect on another level. It contributes to social wellbeing and stimulates vulnerable people's independence and their personal development based on active collaboration and help on the farm. By being in contact with nature and animals, the interaction between children and childminder is less stressful, making it possible for them to learn in a more beneficial way.



City and Environmental Planning



The cooperative offers a summer care service which takes place in the summer months in various communities in South Tyrol. Another available service is taking care of children at events, such as weddings, trade fairs or company celebrations. There is also the possibility to offer childcare for one or more days for visitors at conferences and hotels.

Besides being a great tourism destination, all these services help to boost the province's dynamics.



It is mandatory for the childminders to be certified in order to work for the social cooperative.

The training is carried out in cooperation with the technical schools for agriculture, housekeeping and nutrition in the Autonomous Province of Bolzano - South Tyrol.

An important component of the training and further education is nature education, which forms the foundation of the work of the child minders. Solid training and ongoing training guarantee professional support.



This project was created to solve the problem that is the high level of unemployment considering rural areas. These women farmers have the opportunity to increase their capabilities and skills, improve their social life and experience an alternative practice of reintegration into society and the labour market.
