
Organized by SAMP - Sociedade Artística Musical dos Pousos, and in partnership with several entities throughout the years, the initiative is on it's third collaborative project with Estabelecimento Prisional de Leiria Jovens to ease the reincertion of young inmates in society.



The involvement of different schools and organizations makes a mutual understating and comprehension mandatory for the participation in the project, not just to dance in a synchrony and harmonize the voices, but mainly to make the working environment enjoyable and guarantee a smooth performance.



Teamwork and trust are subtly mandatory when it comes to the complexity of creating such a show as a live opera. Whether with other inmates, dancers or even their families, one must learn to respect and depend on the other, building social skills that will make the transition easier.



The involvement of several schools and organizations of the community in the project connects the prisoners to the surrounding environment, breaking the stigma and combating prejudice through innovative collaborations. The



Production, Distribution and Consumption



Planned and organized by the partner companies, the shows are set and, depending on the audience, the tickets are sold. It could be in the "Mozart Pavillion", the designated space for performances inside the prison, for the inmates' families, or even in Calouste Gulbenkian Foundation Grand Auditorium, open to the general public.



Vocal coaches, dance teachers, choreographers, musicians, artistic directors and many others, offer their advices and train people who never sang or danced before, teaching them new skills and knowledge of performative arts.



Job Creation



It's not rare for someone to have an undiscovered talent, and some of the ex prisioners have already been offered lessons and new opportunities in dance and music schools, thanks to their performance on the project.





The paradox of an opera made by prisioners captures the atention easity, and the language for this kind of situation needs to use a similar contrast: bold fonts in strong colors paired with soft faces of young people.
